PERMISSION TO IMPORT

I, SHARON NYAKUENGAMA, being an officer authorised by the Minister for Home Affairs, pursuant to *Customs (Prohibited Imports) Regulations 1956, Regulation 4H, Schedule 13, Item 1* do hereby give permission for the importation by [REDACTED], [REDACTED] of the items, under the Collectors and Non-Government Museum Test, listed in the schedule below:

The Schedule

One (1) Soviet T-72 Main Battle Tank

(Permanently inoperable for the above items means a calibre size hole (maximum 20mm diameter in guns larger than 40mm calibre) must be bored through the lower half of the barrel. Firing Pin to be cut off and the firing pin hole welded fully closed. A 15mm hole to be bored into the side of buffer cylinder or otherwise deactivate the recoil mechanism)

Conditions

1. Permission to import the items listed in this permit is subject to the production of this original document to Customs and Border Protection.
2. This permission is for one importation and is **valid for twelve months from the date of signature**.
